REPORTS TO COUNCIL:

10a. REWARD FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF SUSPECT(S) IN THE SHARON SANTOS MURDER INVESTIGATION:

Since the disappearance of Ms. Sharon Santos on August 17, 2004 and the subsequent discovery of her body on September 2, 2004, the Burbank Police Department has worked tirelessly to apprehend those responsible for her murder.

Police Chief Tom Hoefel and the investigators on the case believe that a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of suspects(s) involved in the case would be a useful tool. Warner Bros. has offered \$25,000, and the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors has offered \$10,000. Staff is recommending that the City Council approve an appropriation of \$15,000 to bring the total reward to \$50,000.
