Minutes Approved The minutes for the regular meeting of September 5, 2000 were approved as submitted.

PA 2 Treasurer's Report The City Treasurer's report on investment and reinvestment of temporarily idle funds for the third quarter ending September 30, 2000 and fourth quarter ending December 31, 2000 were noted and ordered filed.

PA 2 2001 Investment Policy A report was received from Mr. Rogers, City Treasurer, which stated that the 2001 Investment Policy for the Investment Pool comprised of the City Redevelopment Agency, Parking Authority, Youth Endowment Services and separately for the Housing Authority is being presented for approval.

The report stated that the Treasurer's recommendation is for no change from the 2000 Investment Policy with the exception of allowable maturities that were changed by law as follows:

bank acceptances maximum maturities are changed from 6 months to 180 days; and, prime quality commercial paper maximum maturities are changed from 180 days to 270 days.

The report concluded by noting that the recommended changes were reviewed and approved by the Fiscal and Treasurer's Group and the Treasurer's Oversight Review Committee.

The Parking Authority approved the 2001 Investment Policy.
