- Minutes The minutes for the regular meeting of July 31, 2001 were approved as submitted.

RA 49 At the request of the Redevelopment Agency, Mr. Bates, **RA 60** Redevelopment Project Analyst, presented a brief report on the Economic Dev. & request for Agency sponsorship of the Burbank International Sponsorship Children's Film Festival (BICFF). He explained that the Festival Agrmt. for BICFF provides for a showplace for filmmakers and provides program activities for children. He said this year's second annual Film Festival has been scheduled for the week of October 26 through November 3, 2001. He then said the Redevelopment Agency Economic Development and Sponsorship entered into an Agreement a year ago with organizers of the first annual BICFF with a \$50,000 pledge to help finance the advertising/marketing campaign. He noted that a new agreement has been proposed for the Agency to sponsor this years BICFF with an additional pledge of \$50,000.

> Mr. Bates introduced Chris Shoemaker, BICFF organizer, who introduced staff member Katey Mason, Events Director, and together they discussed the event, the available activities, and

encouraged attendance and participation by the public. Mr. Shoemaker stated that the Festival is working on studio sponsorship to underwrite the admission to all screenings so it will be free to all participants.

Mr. Golonski stated he was not comfortable with the City underwriting essentially 25 percent of the program by putting up another \$50,000 this year and would be interested in having a sunset clause and at some point having the BICFF become self sufficient. He further stated that perhaps each year, the amount subsidized by the Agency could be lessened on a sliding scale until it became self-supporting.

Mr. Ovrom made a suggestion that the Agency could approve the \$50,000 subsidy this year and then develop the sliding scale for subsequent years if they wish.
