Mrs. Donna Anderson, City Treasurer, presented the City's Investment Policy for 2002 for the Investment Pool comprised of the City, Redevelopment Agency, Parking Authority, Youth Endowment Services, and, separately, for the Housing Authority. She noted that, although there are no major changes from the 2001 Policy, there is a larger liquidity amount based on the appropriations Mrs. Anderson reported that she will be submitting the approved Investment Policy to a certification program through the Municipal Treasurers Association of the United States and Canada. Mrs. Anderson stated that this organization will review the Policy and make any recommendations they deem necessary. She stated the policy has already been reviewed by both the State of California Association, Fiscal and Treasurer's Review Group, and the Treasurer's Oversight Review Committee.

The Redevelopment Agency approved the Investment Policy for 2002.
