THE CITY OF BURBANK MUNICIPAL CODE

Sec. 26-102 Discharging of Water Onto Streets, Permit Fee

(a) PROHIBITED – TEMPORARY PERMITS

No person shall negligently, willfully or maliciously discharge, throw or deposit water upon any street in such manner as to obstruct or damage the street, or to create a nuisance or hazard to persons or property, or to prevent or interfere with the free and uninterrupted use of the street by the public; provided however, that the Public Works Director may grant and issue permits for the temporary discharge of water upon the street, upon terms and conditions as he may deem necessary to protect the City and public from damage and injury.

(b) PERMIT

Each application for such permit shall be accompanied by a permit fee in an amount designated in the Burbank Fee Resolution to cover the cost of investigation, inspection and processing the permit together with a cash deposit in an amount deemed sufficient by the Public Works Director to reimburse the City for any expenses it may incur as a result of such use of the street.

Sec. 25-601 Discharge From Swimming Pools

No person shall cause any discharge to enter the storm drain system unless such discharge:

- A. Consists entirely of stormwater;
- B. Consists of nonstormwater that is authorized by a NPDES Permit issued by the U.S. EPA, the state board, or a regional board;
- C. Is associated with emergency fire fighting activities; or
- D. Is otherwise in compliance with the requirements of this chapter.

THE CITY OF BURBANK NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT

Part 1 Discharge Prohibitions, Section 2.c.5

The Permittees shall effectively prohibit non-storm water discharges into the MS4 [Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System] and watercourses, except where such discharges:
